- **Summer Program** offers an enriching program of academics through individual educational therapy, small group instruction, multi-sensory teaching, and project-based learning. **Activities include art, music, keyboarding and leadership/team building games. The program is a good fit for students who can self-regulate so that they and their peers may learn.**
- **All summer instructors are Day School Teachers and staff**, Educational Therapists, or veteran educators.
- **Raskob Day School Teachers** hold special education credentials, and provide an integrated program that accelerates and remediates academic learning while boosting children's self-esteem.
- **Raskob Institute Educational Therapists** are certificated Educational Therapists, and most have a graduate degree in education, special education, educational therapy or a related field.
- **Speech and Language Therapy is offered** as supplemental to the regular programs for an additional fee. *(Student must have existing Speech and Language services or recent evaluation indicating need.)*
